AWANA helps churches and parents work together to develop spiritually strong children and youth who faithfully follow Jesus Christ.

AWANA Clubs is a non-denominational, Bible-centered youth organization providing a weekly program for boys and girls ages 3 through high school. They are carefully organized to provide maximum interest and activity for everyone. The acrostic AWANA comes from the first letters of **A**pproved **W**orkmen **A**re **N**ot **A**shamed (2 Tim. 2:15.)

AWANA CLUBS

Cubbies—for ages three & four. Cubbies encourages preschoolers to develop a respect for God, His Son, and His Word. Must be 3 at the beginning of AWANA to participate.

Sparks—for K5-2nd grade. Sparks club opens up a rich world of Bible truths for curious kindergarteners and 1st & 2nd graders. Must be 5 at the beginning of AWANA to participate.

Truth & Training—for 3rd-6th grade. T & T teaches kids the truth of God's Word and trains them to follow God and practice His grace.
